Parents of Students in PreSchool Program

New Jersey law requires that children aged 6 months to 59 months (or 4 years, 11 months) receive a minimum of one dose of the seasonal flu vaccine, between September 1 and December 31, each year in order to attend school.

Safe. Respectful. Responsible.

Young children are among those at high risk for flu complications and are quite capable of transmitting influenza to their close contacts, including other children, adults, and elderly persons who may be at similarly high risk for complications from influenza infection.

If your child has already received this vaccine, please provide documentation to the School Nurse so their school health record can be updated. If not, please make an appointment **now** with your child's medical care provider so your child can receive this vaccine before December 31, 2023 and not be excluded from school.
